# **Tankless Water Heater Descaling**

Descaling your water heater removes mineral build up that can impact the performance of your system. Excess mineral build up can lead to a clogged system, reduce the operating efficiency, cause fluctuations in your water temperature and ultimately shorten the lifespan of the unit. A clean system will heat more efficiently saving money on your energy bills and keep the unit operating at peak performance. Scale build up on the heat exchanger forces the system to work harder to heat the water. Scale can clog vital components of the system reducing water flow and pressure, removing the deposits ensures a normal water flow. Annual cleaning can help prevent potential damage and safety issues.

# **HVAC Filter Replacement**

You should replace HVAC filters to maintain indoor air quality, improve energy efficiency, reduce strain on the system to prevent costly repairs and system failure and extend the life of your HVAC unit. A clogged filter restricts airflow, forcing the system to work harder, consume more energy and recirculate dust, pollen, and other irritants back into your home's air. Air quality is important for those with respiratory challenges.

# **Lighting Improvements**

Poor lighting can reduce visibility which leads to safety concerns. Ceilings above 8 feet are a wonderful feature until you need to

change a bulb which requires a ladder. Have you ever called a contractor to change a light bulb in the ceiling? Most want \$150 just to show up. Our program will keep a check on your lighting and change out those bulbs keeping you safer.



### **Smoke Alarm Maintenance**
